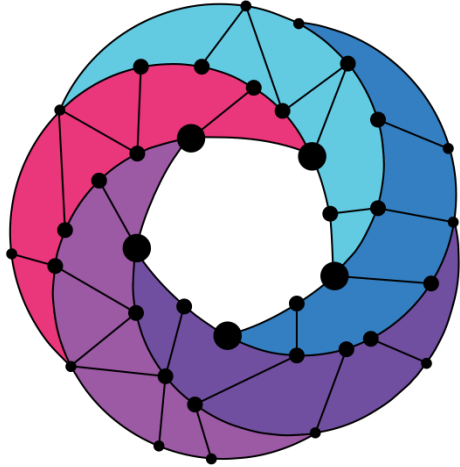

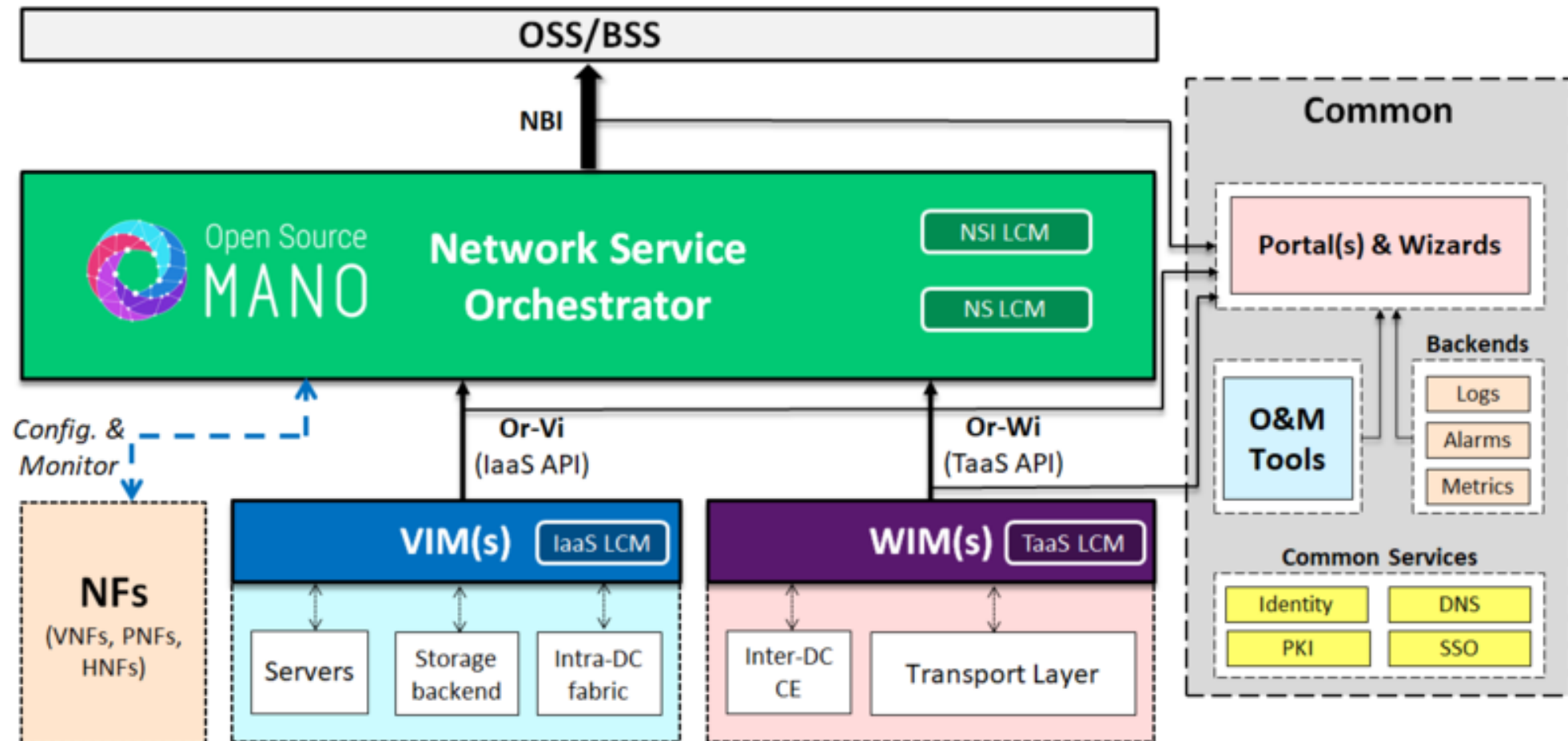


Internship goals

OSM Architecture



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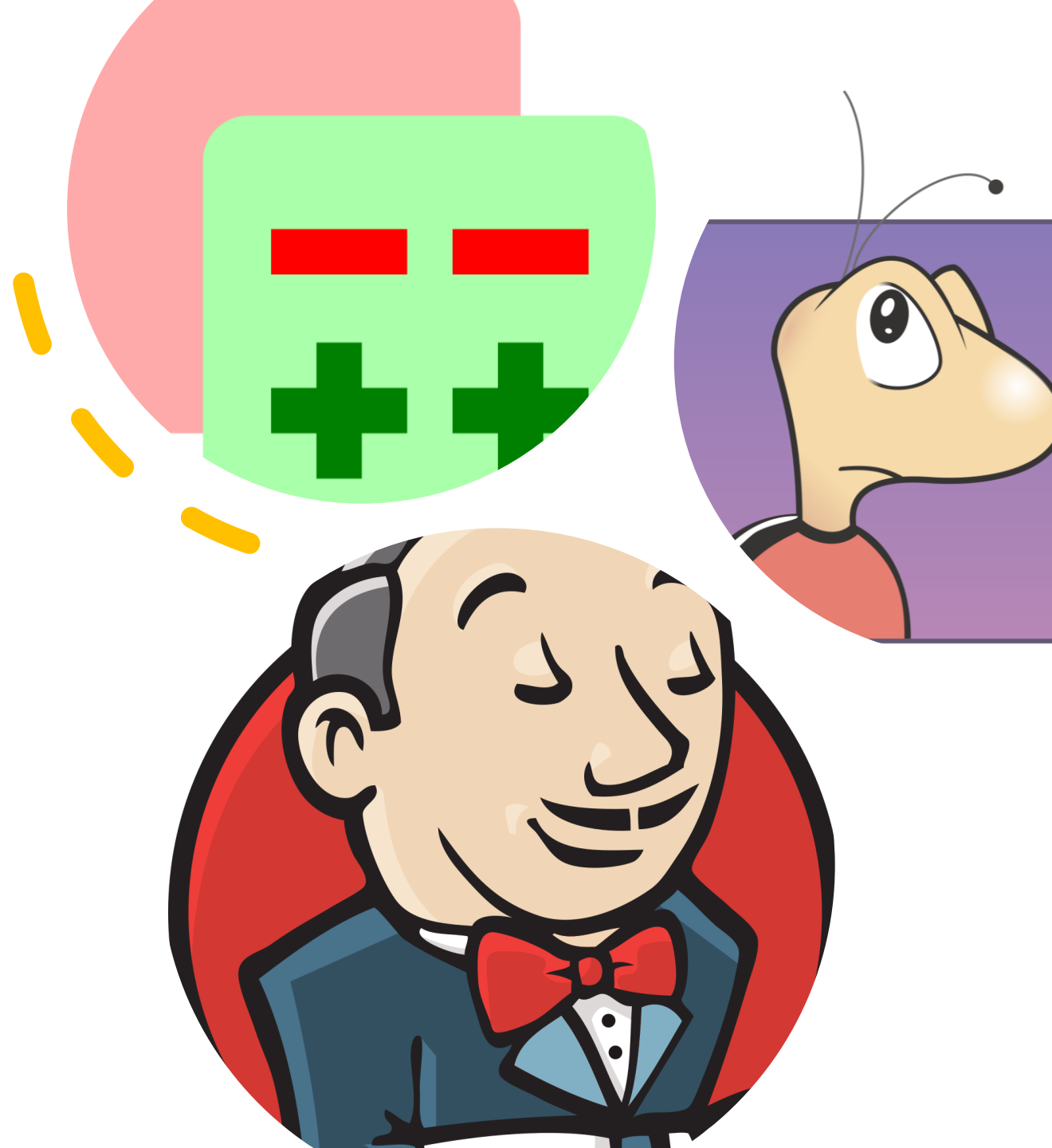


Reviving TST010

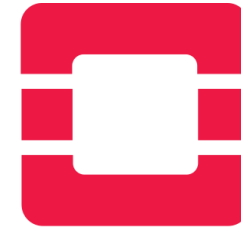

- More modular

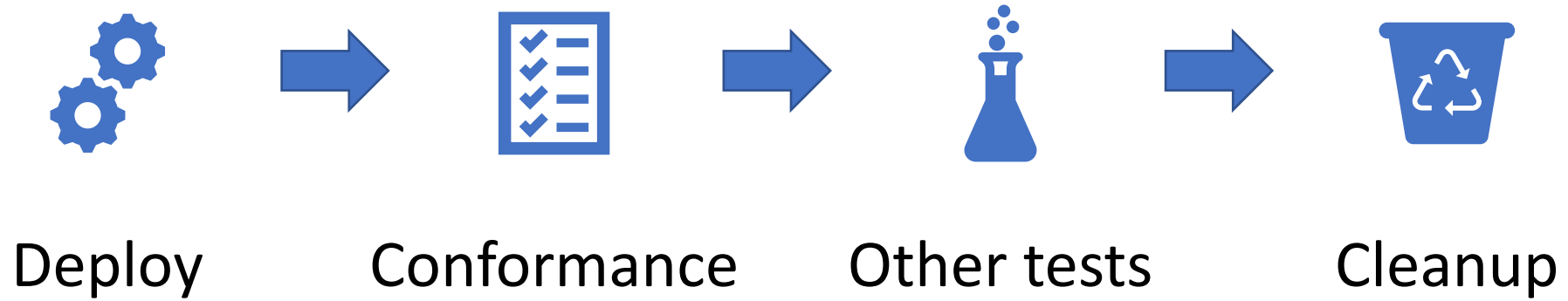

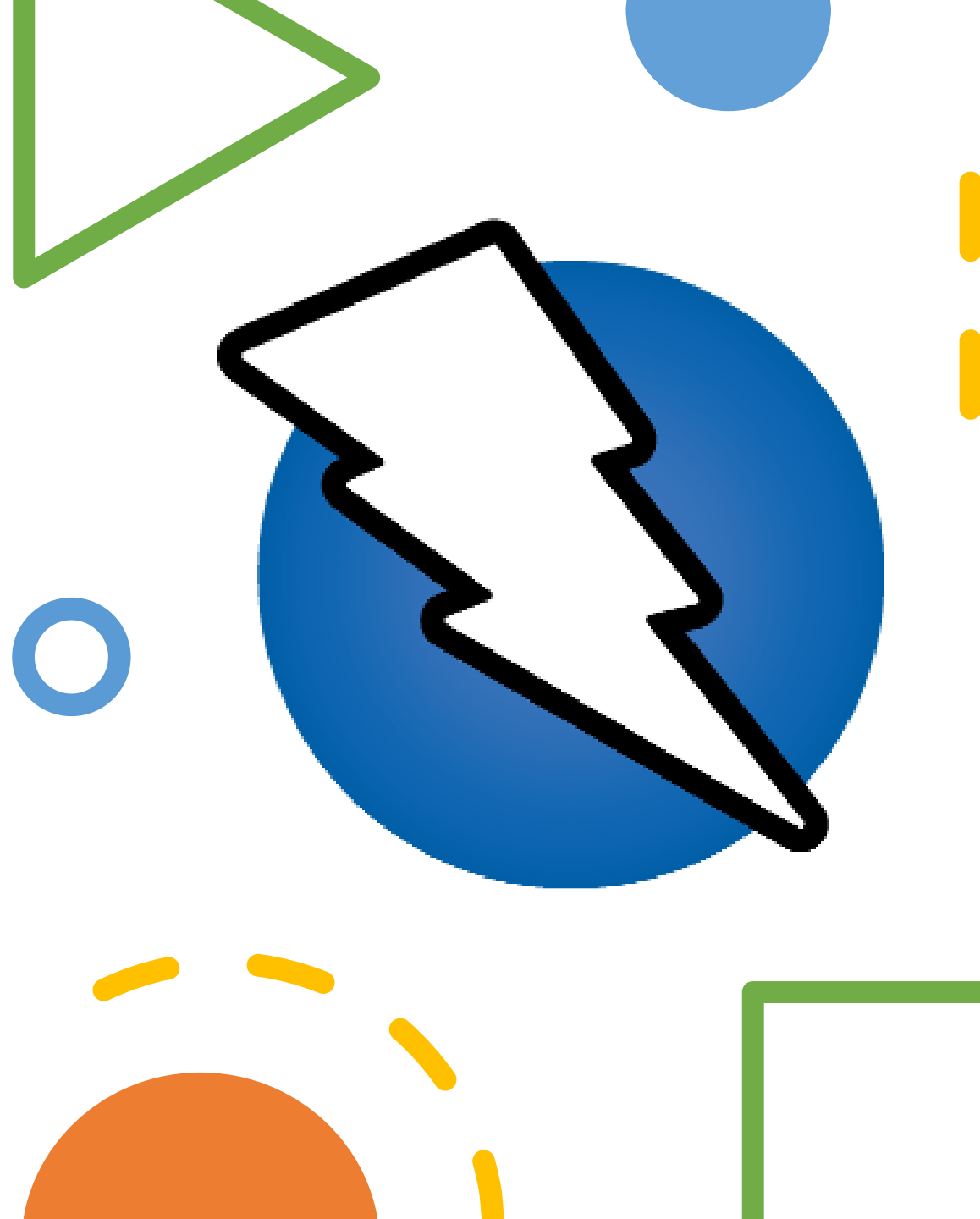
API Fuzzing

- Using Peach Fuzzer
- 128 endpoints tested
- 11 698 API requests (Quick)
- Customizable



DAST

- Using OWASP Zed Attack Proxy (ZAP)
- Web app scanning & API Scanning
- Vulnerabilities:
 - SQL injection
 - Broken Authentication
 - Sensitive data exposure
 - Cross Site Scripting (XSS)
 - Components with known vulnerabilities
 - ...



DAST

- 246 065 API requests
- 13 Security checks:
 - 8 Active checks
 - 5 Passive Checks

Container scanning

- PoC

- More efficient pipeline: push images to container registry and immediately scan

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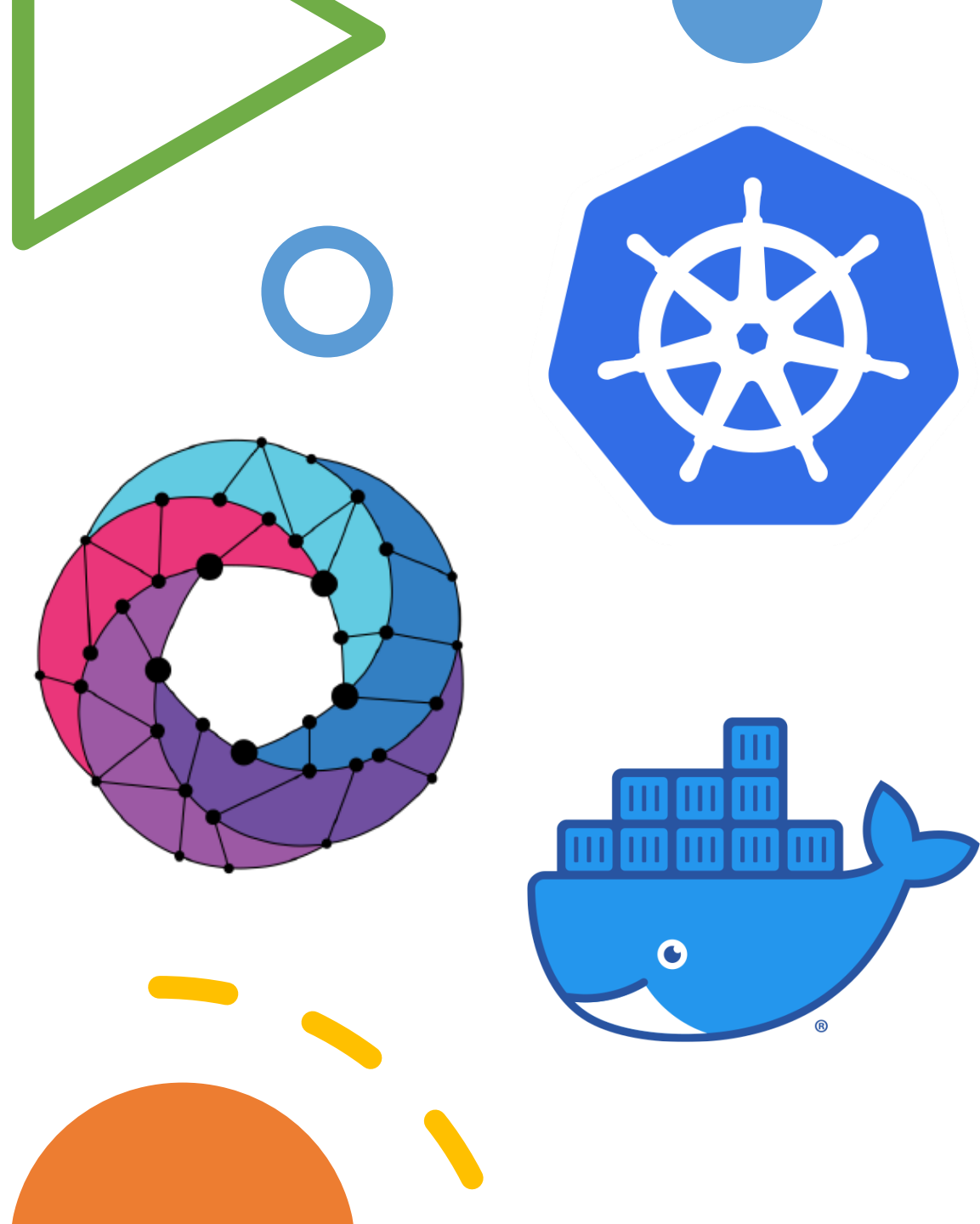


Challenges
